### **REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST**

**Assignment Title: Recruitment of Service Provider for Chicken Processing and Marketing in Nandi County**

**Reference No: KE-NANDI COUNTY-239598-CS-QCBS**

The County government of Nandi is implementing the **National Agricultural and Rural Inclusive Growth Project (NARIGP)**, whose development objective is “to increase agricultural productivity and profitability of targeted rural communities in selected Counties,” and intends to apply part of the project funds to engage a service provider to facilitate chicken processing and marketing.

The County government has established a chicken slaughter house, in Kapsabet town, in partnership with Kocheng’gei cooperative society, which is intended to process chicken from farmers and improve market access. In order to support the functionality and operationalization of the slaughter house, the County government is seeking to engage the services of a service provider to execute the assignments listed below:

- (a) Preparation of consolidated proposal documents for facility upgrading and operations management
- (b) Upgrading of the chicken processing Facility to functionality
- (c) Management of the chicken processing facility operations

The County Government of Nandi now invites eligible private firms to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested service providers should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are:

- i) Minimum of five years' relevant experiences and technical capacity in provision of relevant technical, business, financial and organizational development services;
- ii) At least three (3) assignments of similar nature in the past five years, one of which should have been in similar value chain; and
- iii) Demonstrable experience and competence in providing services on chicken processing and marketing.

The attention of interested Service providers is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank's *Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants [under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants] by World Bank Borrowers*, January 2011 Revised July 2014 ("Consultant Guidelines"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest, which shall be applied in this procurement.

Service providers may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub-consultancy to enhance their qualifications. All the members of the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire assignment. However, the experience of sub-consultant will not be considered while short-listing.

Successful SPs will be selected in accordance with the **Selection Based on the Consultants' Qualifications (CQS)** method set out in the Consultant Guidelines, which shall be adopted in this procurement.

Interested bidders are invited for a site visit/ meeting at the slaughter house on 25/6/2021 starting from 11am to 1pm.
